

WORDING OF CHARTER FOR CHURCH

Filed with Commonwealth of Massachusetts June 28, 1883

Amended July 21, 1977 [to include IRS 501(C)3 Wording]

Originally, **Working Union of Progressive Spiritualists**; then, **The Spiritual Fraternity**; now, **First Spiritual Temple**:

FOUNDED FOR THE PURPOSE OF establishing a religious society for the promulgation of the truths and principles of Spiritualism in the practical work of self-culture, mentally, morally, physically, and spiritually, through the instrumentalities of spirit communion, lectures, libraries, lyceums, asylum homes and healing institutes.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. No part of the net earnings will inure to the benefit of private shareholders or individuals. Upon dissolution, assets will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or state, or local government for public purpose.
